The Rotary Polio Plus program has eradicated polio in all but 4 countries in the world. In response to the \$100 million grant from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, RI is undertaking a 3 year fundraising challenge to match the Gates donation.

Our club has pledged to raise \$2000.00 by 2010.
