Sherry invited former Rotarian P.J. Keeler to talk to us about his job as EMS Coordinator for Columbia County.



His job requires him to be the liaison with residents, hospitals, county, state and other government agencies. He joins Jim Van Deusen, Fire, and Bill Black,

Emergency Management as the three Emergency Coordinators in the county.

He is the chair of the EMS Task Force, is responsible for compliance with NYS regulations, and teaches EMS courses.

The squads in CC respond to 9,000 ER calls a year with 14 squads, 150 paid staffers and 120 volunteers.

After 9/11 the county sent 10 ambulances for 28 days to work in the recovery effort.

P.J. gave us a history of the EMS in the US and an overview of the intricacies of providing service to the community.

Most interesting program. We invited him to come see us again.
